#### **Case Summary**

Rutaginara was indicted and tried on one account before the ICTR.

#### **Trial Phase**

### Count 1: Crime against Humanity (Extermination): Pleaded guilty

The Chamber found Rutaginara guilty of extermination as a crime against humanity.

The Chamber found Rutaginara had prior knowledge of attacks which took place at Mubuga church in April 1994 where thousands of Tutsi civilians were killed. Despite his position and prior knowledge of the attacks, the Chamber found that Rutaginara failed to protect the Tutsis either before or after the attacks.

#### **Sentence**

The Chamber sentenced Rutaginara to six years imprisonment.

Rutaginara was released on 2 March 2008.
